

**POLICE OFFICER DECLARATION RESOLUTION
POLICE AND FIRE PERA FUND**

WHEREAS, the policy of the State of Minnesota as declared in MN Statutes 353.63 is to give special consideration to employees who perform hazardous work and devote their time and skills to protecting the property and personal safety of others; and

WHEREAS, MN Statutes Section 353.64 permits governmental subdivisions to request coverage in the Public Employees Police and Fire plan for eligible employees of police or sheriff departments whose position duties meet the requirements stated therein and listed below.

BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Coleraine hereby declares that the position of part time police officer and school liaison, currently held by Adrian Nelson, meets all of the following Police and Fire Plan membership requirements:

1. Said position requires a license by the MN peace officer standards and training board under sections 626.84 to 626.863 and this employee is so licensed;
2. Said position's primary (over 50%) duty is to enforce the general criminal laws of the state;
3. Said position charges this employee with the prevention and detection of crime;
4. Said position gives this employee the full power of arrest, and
5. Said position is assigned to a designated police or sheriff's department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this governing body hereby requests that the named employee be accepted as a member of the Public Employees Police and Fire Plan effective the date of acceptance of this resolution by the governmental subdivision.
