The damage caused by the storms in August to Midway Ln. have been repaired.

Bargen Inc. have completed the crack sealing on rural roads within the annexed area.

The repairs have been completed to the catch basin on Mitchell St. and West Ave. along with three other catch basins that needed backs installed.

On 9-22-2020 I was notified of a sink hole that opened up on corner of Roosevelt St. and Kerr Ave. I met with Casper const. and the repair was completed on the 24th. Probable cause of the wash out was two roof drains assuming from the school that were not connected to the structure.

Jim Ohman has completed the asphalt patches on the streets and alleys that had been excavated due to previous water brakes.

The mowing of the ditches within the annexed area have been completed.

The transmission for the repairs on the pickup has been ordered.

The John Deere Gator has been ordered through the cares act.

The Pickup has been ordered, as of now the in-service date will not be until late spring.
