

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

A special meeting was held beginning at 3:30 p.m. on **Monday, November 29th, 2021** in the Council Chambers of Coleraine City Hall and via TEAMS meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 5:08 p.m. by Mayor Nielsen.

Roll Call: Mayor Nielsen, Councilpersons Pollard, T. Troumbly, and Soltzak.
Councilperson Sertich was absent with notice.

Resolution No. 2021.11.29 – Blandin Foundation – A motion was made by Mayor Nielsen, supported by Councilperson Pollard, **to approve resolution to apply to and accept up to \$100,000 in funds from the Blandin Foundation – 2021 Itasca Area Small Communities Development Grant Program.** Roll Call: Ayes: Mayor Nielsen, Councilpersons Pollard, T. Troumbly, and Soltzak.

The application will list the following projects and dollar amounts, subject to change:

- Log Church restoration -- \$70,000
- Longyear Park and parking lot renovation -- \$280,000
- Update City website -- \$5,000
- Golf Course lake lot front dock (bldg. and dock) -- \$30,000
- Ski Hill -- \$50,000
- Cotton Park playground equipment -- \$25,000

Council then received a report with citizen concerns on the proposed Waste Management routes that the office and council has been fielding.


After a lengthy discussion Mayor Nielsen Made a **motion to push off the trial of any new route until City can talk with Waste Management about same side alley pickup – put off any changes indefinitely – asking them to wait until spring and until everyone can be notified about the change in any garbage route.** Councilperson Soltzak seconded the motion. Ayes: all. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Waste Management will be contacted; City will notify residents regarding no change in route or pick up.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:35 p.m.
